Jan Rowe Capps - Improving Health and Education in Greensboro

Jan was appointed the President of the Moses Cone Wesley Long Community Health Foundation, effective July 2007 – a position that brought her out of retirement. She is also a Board member for Communities in Schools of Greater Greensboro.

Always engaged in what matters, Jan serves on the Board of Trustees for Guilford Day School and was recently appointed to the Board of Visitors for the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. She previously served on the Board of the United Way of Greater Greensboro, the Board of Advisors for UNC-G's Bryan School of Business and on the Board of Governors for “2 Those Who Care”, the Community Awards arm for WFMY-2. We've also seen her picture in the paper recently as a Board member of the newly formed Premier Commercial Bank.

Jan retired from Syngenta in 2005 as Vice President of Human Resources for the North American organization. She also held leadership positions with Syngenta in Finance and Strategic Planning during her 26 years with the company. Jan was a WPFer during her Syngenta career.
